Report from the Board of Governors of the Foundation (stichtingsbestuur) 2018

General information about the Foundation

The Foundation has been established on 14 March 2018. The Foundation is established with the purpose to guide and support children gifted in the sphere of music and arts by providing favorable conditions for their creative growth and organizing their international activities.

The Foundation is supervised by a Board of Governors, consisting of 3 people, a Managing Director, and an Advisory Board.

The Foundation will maintain and develop cultural values, traditions and collaboration between young talents from Europe and Russia. The Foundation has signed a cooperation agreement with the Vladimir Spivakov International Charity Foundation in Januari 2019. Other main partners are the Gnessin Music School in Moscow, Conservatorium of Amsterdam, etc.

Information regarding the activities of the Foundation in 2018

In 2018, the Foundation has been involved in the following activities:

Moscow Meet Friends, October 2018

Joint concert in CvA Amsterdam with students from Genssin Music School, Amsterdam.

Information regarding the Board of Governors in 2018

The Board of Governors have met 4 times during the year. In addition to discussion on specific activities for the Foundation, the Board have discussed its corporate governance, administrative organization and internal controls, privacy statements, ethics & compliance, procedures around certificates of good conduct for the Board and volunteers, etc.

Review of the financial situation

The first financial year of the Foundation has been mainly focused on establishing the Foundation and building good relationships with partners and stakeholders. Operational activities have been limited. Costs related to the establishing of the Foundation and operational costs have been financed by the individual member of the Board of Governors and the Managing Director.

This related in total costs of € 1.784. There has been no income in 2018.

Expectations

The Foundation will organize its first activities in 2019. This includes a project which have been named 'The New Bach', where Russian organ students will have the opportunity to play at church organs in the Netherlands. The Foundation expects that its operational costs for maintaining the Foundation will be covered by the proceeds of this project.
